I. Information about our use of Cookies

Our website uses Cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Exelcius Prime Cookies Disclosure provides the user with information related to the cookies set when you visit an Exelcius Prime website and how to reject or delete those cookies. Users should be familiar with the Exelcius Prime Privacy Policy; which sets out our Cookies Policy.

II. Types of Cookies

Exelcius Prime uses the following type of cookies:

- **Session cookies**

These are temporary cookies that remain in the cookie file of your device's browser only during your visit and are deleted when you close the browser.

- **Permanent cookies (persistent cookies)**

Those cookies remain on your browser even after the browser closes, sometimes for one year or more (the exact length of stay depends on the lifetime of each cookie). Permanent cookies are used when the site administrator may need to know who you are for more than one visit (e.g., remembering your username or your site configuration preferences).

- **First-party cookies**

These are cookies installed on the browser and / or hard drive of your device from the site you are visiting. This includes assigning a unique identifier to you to monitor your site navigation. Website administrators often use first-party cookies to manage visits and for identification purposes.

- **Third-party cookies**

These are cookies used by third parties, such as social networks to track your visits to the various sites they advertise. The site administrator has no control over these third-party cookies.

III. Services and Third-Party Tools

Service providers may use cookies and these cookies may be stored on your computer when you visit our site.

We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of our site. Google Analytics collects information about the use of the site through cookies. The information collected about our site is used to generate reports about the use of our site. Google's privacy policy is available at <https://www.google.com/policies/privacy/>.

Please note that third parties (including, for example, advertising networks and providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

IV. Collection of Information

The information that we collect is used to communicate with you about our Services and to inform you about our policies and terms and to respond to you when you contact us.

V. The Cookies we use

Exelcius Prime uses Cookies for the following purposes:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a credit card or make use of e-billing services.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests.

VI. Deletion of Data

Please note that the data is stored for as long as necessary to provide services to you and other users, including those described above. The information related to you will remain stored until you request for deletion. For further information please read our Privacy Notice.

VII. How to manage these Cookies



The installation of Cookies is only allowed with the consent of the visitor/user and after the appropriate update.

In addition, you may block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. Most browsers allow you to deny cookies and delete cookies. Methods for this purpose differ from the browser and the version in the release. However, you can get up-to-date information about blocking and deleting cookies through these links:
